Euso - a new name for *Eusora* Saaristo, 1998 (Araneae: Ochyroceratidae)

In a paper published recently (Saaristo 1998) I described a new ochyroceratid genus *Eusora*. Unfortunately I failed to notice that the name *Eusora* has been used earlier for a leafhopper genus (Oman 1949). Thus *Eusora* Saaristo, 1998 is a junior homonym of *Eusora* Oman, 1949 and must be rejected. Therefore a new name *Euso* is hereby proposed to replace *Eusora* Saaristo, 1998

The first record of a sea bean *Entada rheedii* Sprengel (Mimosaceae) from Seychelles appears in Robertson (1989) but is a sight record only of a seed that had washed up on a beach on Praslin and was subsequently germinated artificially. There is no further mention
